TRAVEL BY PLANE & TRANSFER TO HOTEL

Charleston International Airport (CHS) has connecting flights from 18 airports in 14 US cities. It is located 30 minutes from Wild Dunes and can be accessed by taxi (\$60), rental car or Coastal Limo. Coastal Limo Service can provide transportation to/from the airport for \$30pp based on two people per car. Go to http://www.coastallimocharleston.com/iash to make reservations.

The following airlines have daily flights into CHS: **American Airlines** from Dallas-Ft. Worth and Miami; **Delta** from Atlanta, Detroit, NYC-LGA, NYC-JFK; **Jet Blue** from Washington National, NYC-JFK, Boston; **Southwest** from Chicago Midway, Baltimore, Houston, Nashville; **United** from Washington Dulles, Chicago O'Hare, Newark, Houston Hobby, and **US Airways** from Charlotte, Philadelphia, Washington National.

PASSPORT

A valid passport is required to enter the United States. You are also advised to contact the US Embassy or your consulate before traveling if you have questions.

ON-SITE REGISTRATION

Symposium registration will open on Sunday, October 4, at 14.00 Hours, in the Board Room at the Boardwalk Inn. It will continue throughout the week in the Foyer of the Sweetgrass Pavilion.

REGISTRATION FEE INCLUDES

Your registration fee includes four days of technical sessions, all program materials, lunch and breaks, as well as a poster session and networking receptions. It also includes the IASH Awards Dinner. Some U. S. Government employees may be required to pay separately for the Awards Dinner. Membership in the International Association for Stability, Handling and Use of Liquid Fuels for the years 2016-2017 and access to the symposium proceedings in the online IASH Library are included.

DRESS CODE

The dress code for the meeting and receptions is Business Casual. The Awards Banquet will be held at the Boone Hall Plantation where you will be walking on grass, so flat shoes are suggested for women. Generally, the dress code in Charleston is light clothing in early Fall with a sweater or light jacket for evening.

TEMPERATURE & TIME ZONE

Charleston is located on the Atlantic Ocean in the Southern region of the United States. The weather should be mild with minimal chance of rain. The average temperatures in October range from 78°F - 60°F (18°C - 10°C). The Time Zone is US Eastern Daylight Time (EDT).

TIPPING

Tipping is always at your discretion but 20% is the norm at most restaurants depending upon the service you receive. Cab drivers always appreciate a tip at about 10%.

Tours for Spouses/Guests of delegates will be available during the week. The tours brochure will be sent to registrants and will also be available on the IASH website.

EVENING NETWORKING EVENTS

<u>Sunday, October 4</u> – Join us for a *Taste of Charleston* reception at the Grand Pavilion at Wild Dunes located on the Atlantic Ocean. This event will provide an excellent opportunity to network with your peers and make new friends and greet old ones in a beautiful setting.

<u>Monday, October 5</u> - A dedicated Technical Poster Session and Reception will be held in the Exhibition Hall and Foyer at the Sweetgrass Pavilion. Representatives will be available to provide one-on-one discussions about the technical posters that will be presented. Exhibits will also be on display.

<u>Wednesday, October 7</u> – The IASH Awards Dinner will be held at the Boone Hall Plantation, a typical Southern Plantation from the 1700's. When cotton became king of agriculture in the South, Boone Hall was a giant of the Low Country's plantation culture. The dinner will be held in the Cotton Dock, which is situated along the banks of the Wampacheeoone Creek near the plantation home.

Thursday, October 8 - A Closing Reception will be held at Wild Dunes.
